



Atlanta's Imperative Need For a Public Market.

of the Chamber of Commerce to provide Atlant support of everyone who values his own and the munity's welfare. The time has come when the con tinued lack of a public market will prove a grave menace to the city's growth and prosperity. Recent Government reports show that with the exception of Boston the cost of living, particularly in respect to ta ble supplies, is higher in Atlanta than in any other American city. This remarkable condition is due not to any natural circumstance, for, we are in the heart of a wondrously fruitful region but chiefly to the fact that we have no means of direct exchange between the producers and the consumers of food stap eniral market where those who buy and those who sell may meet each day for their common advantage.
Atlanta's unenviable distinction in this regard must be wiped out; ske must take prompt, effective steps to reduce her burdensome and artificial cost of living, or suffer seriously both abroad and at home.

The means of relief is obvious and easily able. A public market, or series of markets, access The municipal market at Des Moines, Iowa, recently established in response to an insistent popular de figures show, price reductions ranging from twenty to one hundred per cent and an average reduction of more than thirty-five per_cent. The cost of table com-modities such as fruits, vegetables, eggs and butter, was lowered during the first week of the market's operation and remained on a normal level. The mayor of Des Moines, states that potatoes, which had sold for sixty cents a peck the day before the market opened, could thereafter be bought for forty cents; that the price of cabbage fell from ten to five cents a pound; that cooking apples sold in the public man whereas they had previously been retailed at from forty to fifty cents; that fresh eggs from the farm were offered at the market for sixteen cents a dezen, while eggs of doubtful age had been sold for twenty cents; and that in divers other commodities propotionate reductions were brought about. Due all ance must be made, of course, for the difference be-tween the general scale of prices in Georgia and Iowa, but it is none the less evident that a public market in Atlanta would yield results equally as gratifying as that in Des Moines.

This is but one among scores of instances show-

ing the power of a market to maintain prices that are at once fair to the consumer, to the producer and to all others concerned. Some seasons age the


