

Five Women Who Grew Into a Great Army

One rainy afternoon, less than two years ago, five women met in the apartment of one of them in New York.

They met to talk about the climbing price of food. Perhaps, as they sipped their tea, they chatted a little about other things too, but FOOD was the main topic of their discourse.

The price of it was the leading thought, but in discussing how to get lower prices, the incidental questions of where and when, of sanitation and freshness and so on, came into the count.

There were just five of these women. They got busy.

Today there are 750,000 in the organization which these five formed that rainy afternoon.

These three-quarters of a million women are the Housewives' League. They are doing things. They are going to do more things. They are all over the country. Nearly all the cities have branches.

The League is working for four objects: Clean Shops, Fair Prices, Pure Products, Efficiency.

The women have gone right after these desirables and, as is the way of the determined, they are getting them.

Here are a few instances of what's going on:

In Lexington, Ky, the women tackled two ice companies which, by ate agreement, had discontinued weighing the ice. The Housewives lended that if the drivers could guess at the weight, the customer could private agreement, had discontinued weight contended that if the drivers could guess at the guess at the bill. They weigh all the ice now.

In Ithaca, N. Y., the branch has adopted as its slogan: "Every House wife an inspector!" They're strong on going to market in person.

In Portland, Me., the League wasn't a month old until it inaugurated "Sanitation and Cash" campaign. The grocers are smiling all the time ow as a result.

San Francisco Leaguers are being urged to GO to market themselves and know their grocers personally.

Detroit is particularly active. They have put through a bakeries in-spection, a pure-milk campaign, a full-weight ordinance, and are co-operat-ing in a movement to prevent the sale of live stock that has been crippled, frozen or strangled in shipping.

In St. Paul, Minn., Pres. John W. Lux, of the National Association of Retail Grocers, and J. C. Doncaster, Secretary of the St. Paul Retail Grocers Association, formally requested that they be admitted to member-ship in the League. They claimed to be eligible because they were in-terested in whatever the League might do. So this branch decided to let the men come in.




