#### Perfecting the Tariff Bill.

Through the pressure of wholesome public opin-ion, two unwise amendments to the tariff bill have been eliminated. One of these sought to weaken the restrictions which the House had thrown around the importation of wid-bird plumage; it was dropped in the Senate caucus. The other proposed a duty of


