

Ga., the alumni of Cornell University in Western Pennsylvania are signing a petition to Gov. Slaton asking executive clemency. Copies of the petition were sent to more than 300 members of the Cornell Club, of Western Pennsylvania, on Dec. 23, and, according to the officers of the organization, it is expected that the response will be unanimous.

The movement may assume a nationwide scope. There are seventy-one Cornell Clubs, and it is thought that the signatures of the tens of thousands of members might have a bearing upon future developments in the case.
