
Leonard Haas, Defended Leo Frank in 1913 Trial

ATLANTA, Jan. 29 (AP) — Leonard Haas, defense lawyer in the widely known 1913 murder trial of Leo Frank, died here yesterday.

Mr. Haas, was the first representative of the American Civil Liberties Union in Georgia.

Frank, an Atlanta factory manager, was convicted of killing 15-year-old Mary Phagan. He was lynched by night riders two years later after his sentence was commuted from death to life imprisonment.

Mr. Haas is survived by his widow; two sons, Leonard Jr. and John, and a brother.
